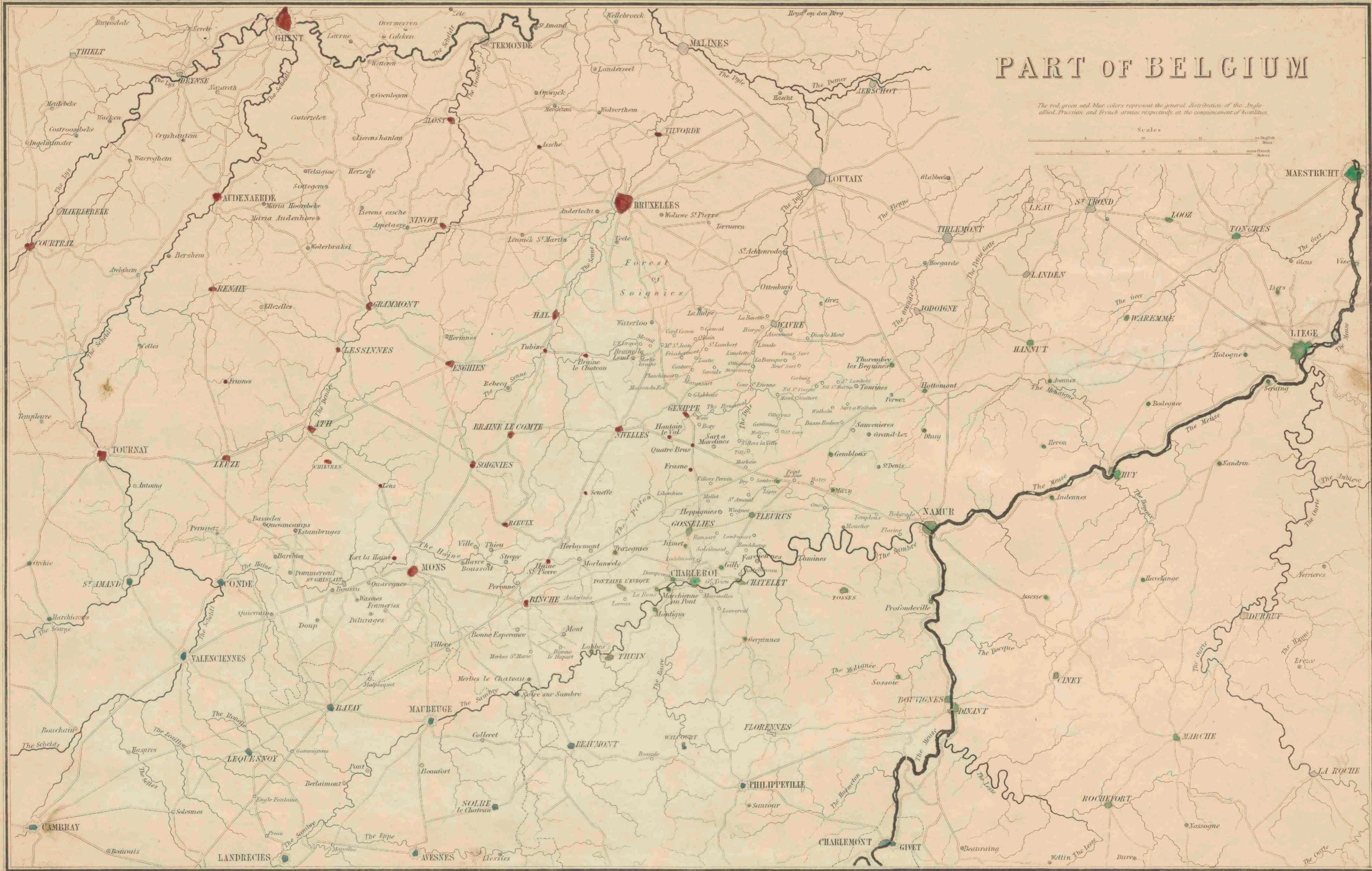

The red, green and blue colors represent the general distribution of the Anglo-allied, Prussian and French armies respectively, at the commencement of hostilities.



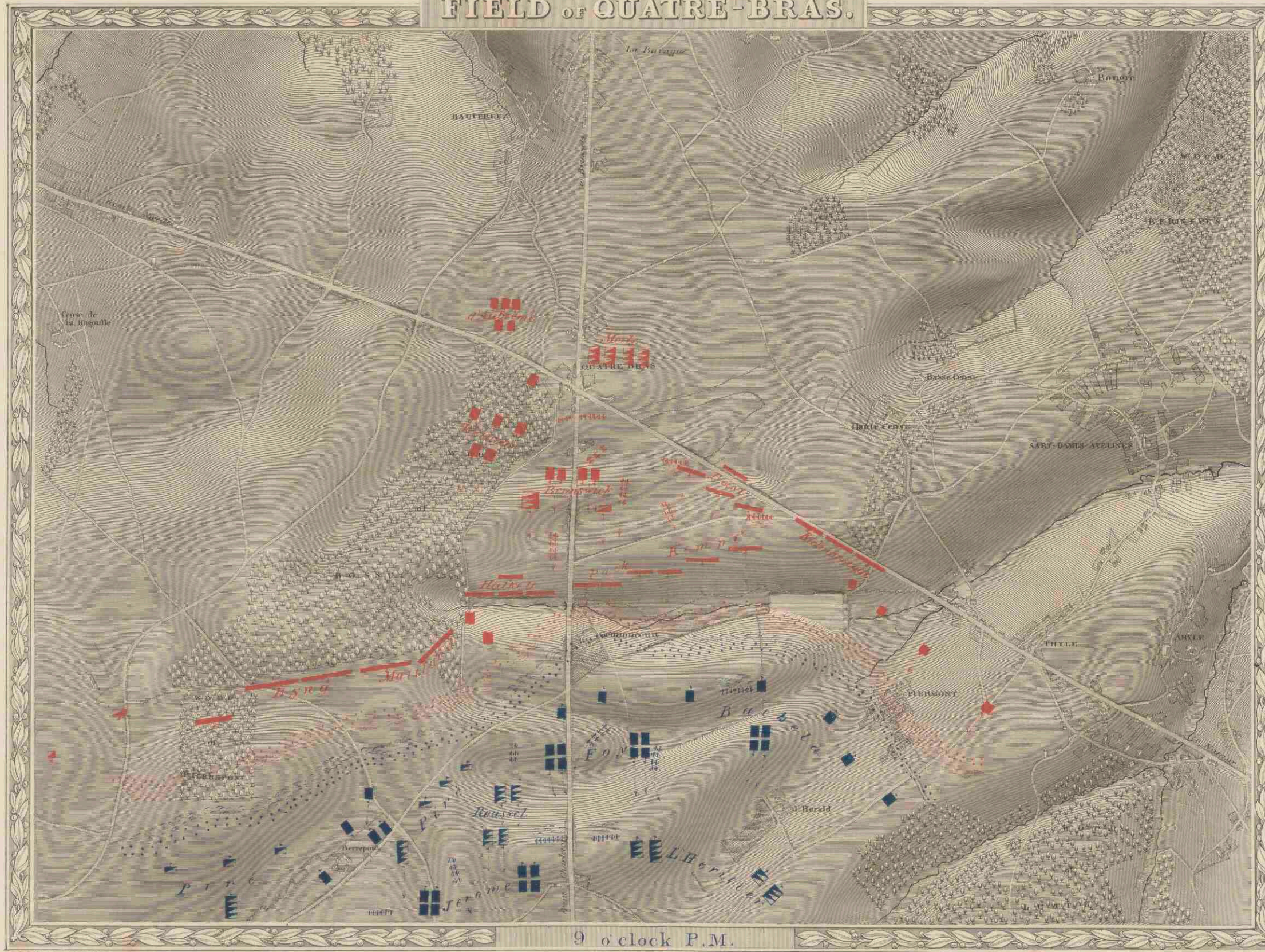

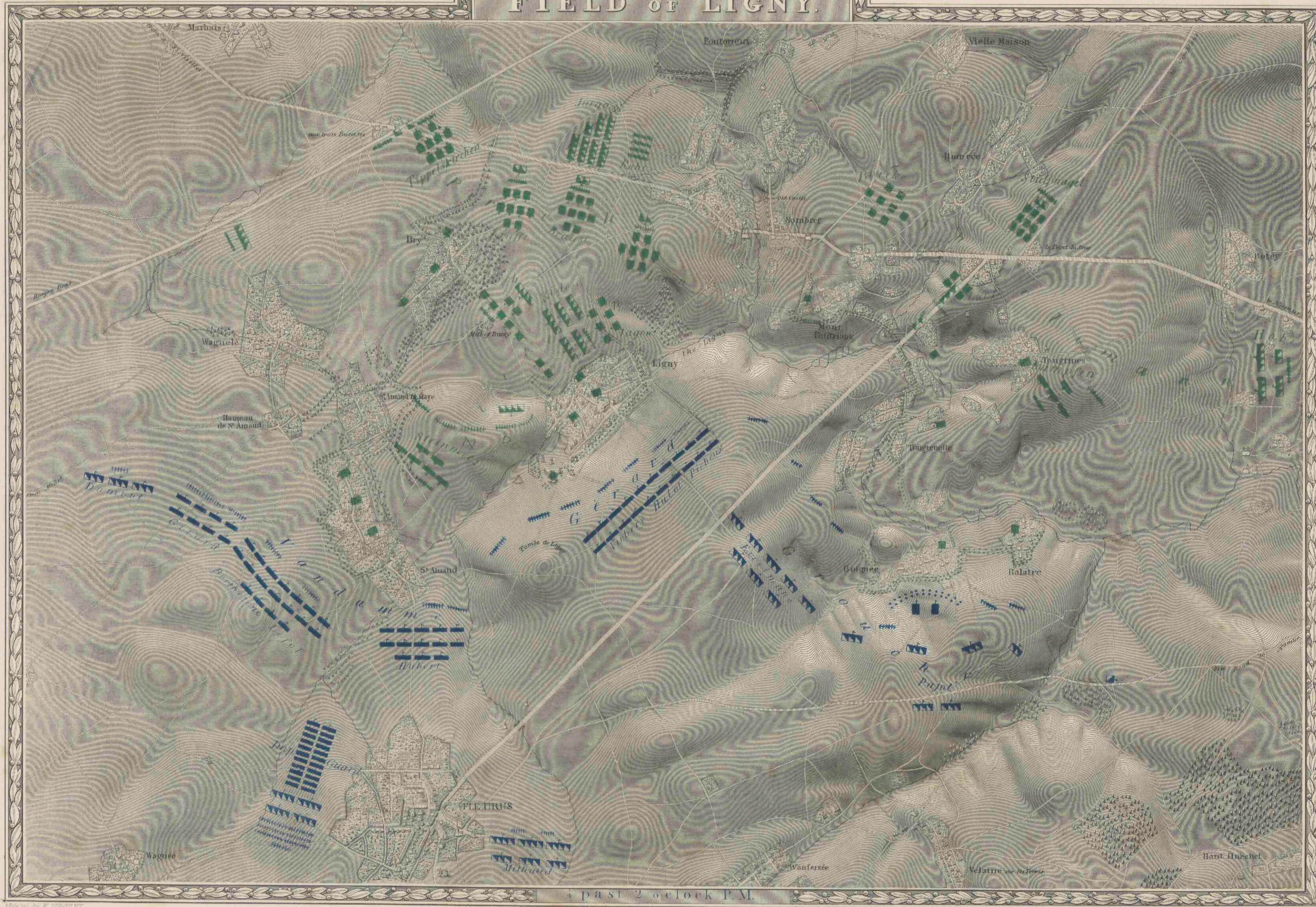

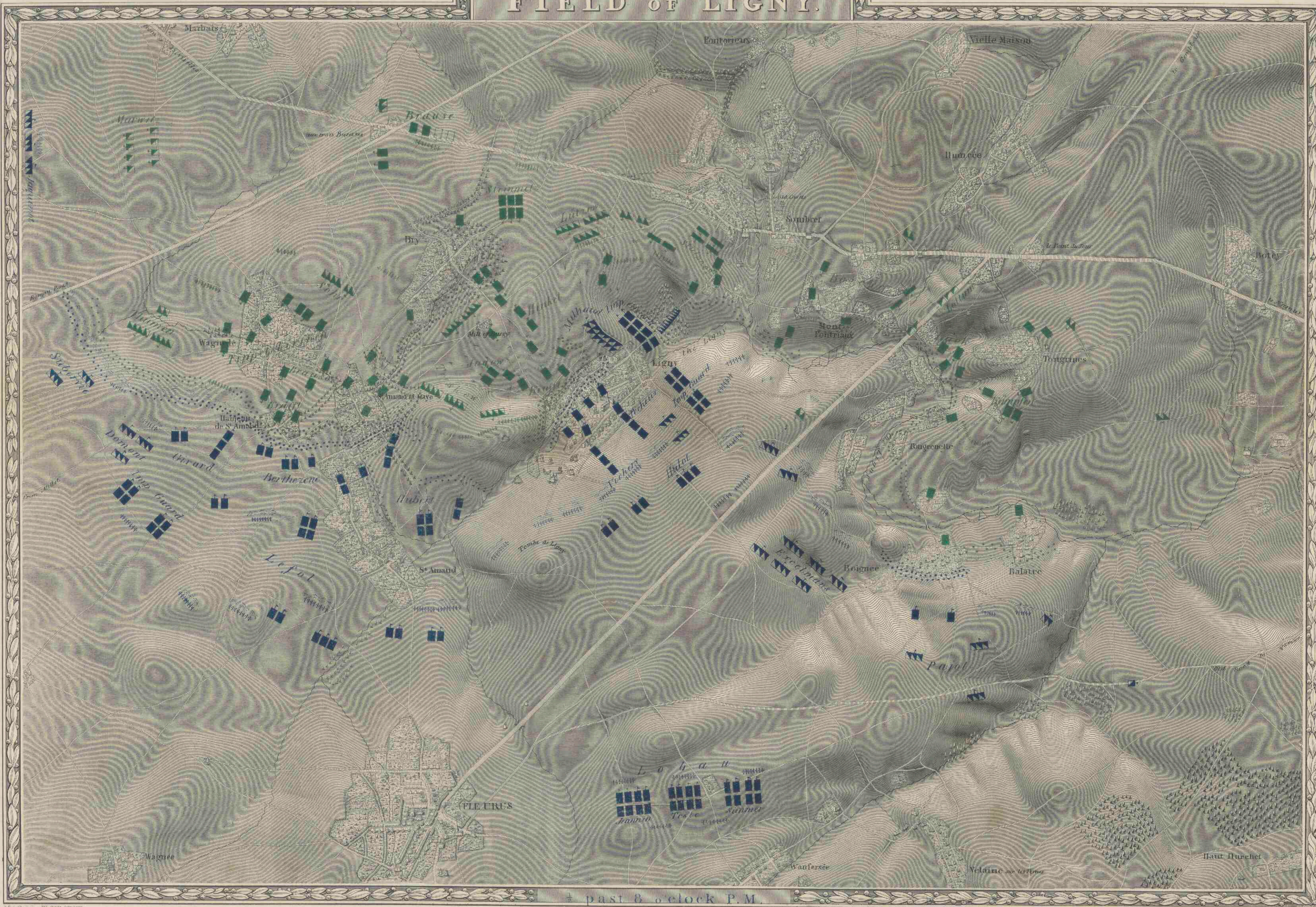

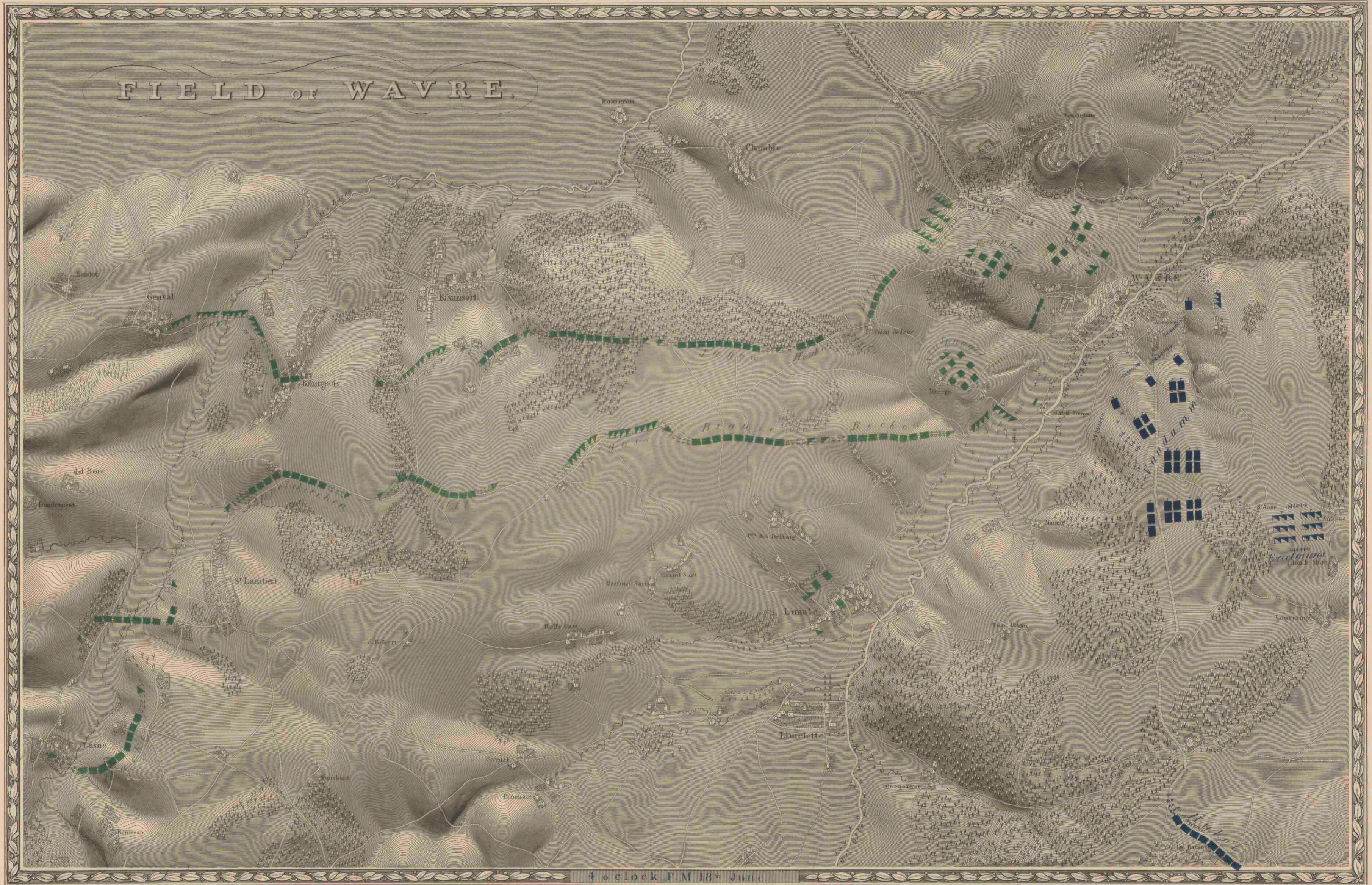

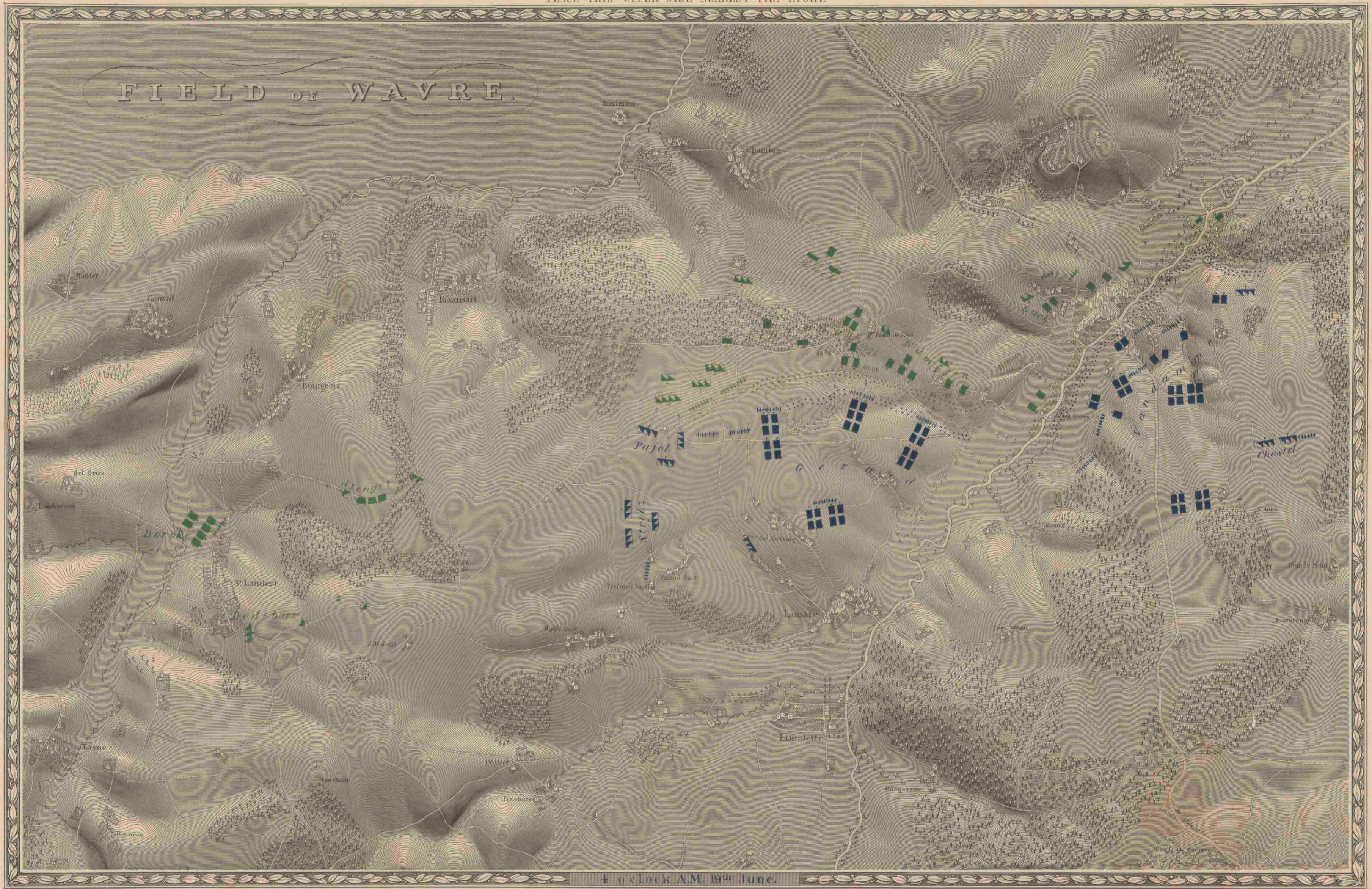
